

Navigating Moodle as a Guest

1. Go to <https://lms.nh.gov/dhhs/dcyf>
2. Scroll down the “Course categories”
3. Click on “DCYF Core Academy”
4. Click on “Core Academy Courses – NO Credit”
5. Find the course you wish to review and click on the course

 - b. Course evaluation (provides feedback to CWEP and the instructor)
 - c. Wrap up – reiterates the knowledge that was expected to be gained by taking the course (course outcomes)
